**INSTRUCTIONS**

1. No person will be excluded from consideration of the scholarship award on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin or sex.
2. All information provided with the application will be used solely for the purpose of granting scholarship awards. It will be kept confidential and destroyed after retention is no longer necessary.
3. Awards will be made to high school seniors and those who have completed their GED and entering the first year of study at an institution within the United States of America and their territories of higher learning, e.g. college, trade school, vocational technical school, leading to a degree or certificate of completion
4. Awards will be made on the basis of demonstrated financial need, academic performance and/or promise. Finalists may be asked to appear before the committee for a personal interview.
5. The committee expects that the applicants have already applied for a Pell Grant from the Federal Government and will utilize the Student Aid Report (SAR) to determine the financial need of the applicant. It usually takes four weeks to longer to obtain an SAR after applying for the basic grant. You should therefore allow sufficient time for that process because the photo static copy of the SAR must be stapled to your application.
6. Applicants should complete both pages of the application form carefully, neatly using typewriter or printing in ink.
7. Applicants should bring both the award application form and the SAR and the SAT scores to your school Guidance Counselor who will attach a copy of your high school transcript and forward these records to:

8. Application deadline is April 15, 2017. It is imperative that 1) both pages of the application form be completed, 2) all pages of SAR, 3) high school transcript and AT scores are received by the committee postmarked April 15, 2017 in order to be considered.
9. Award winners will be notified late in the current academic year. All awards will be made by check payable to the student and the post secondary institution after receipt if the post secondary institution's invoice.
